WEDNESDAY, MARCH 7 – Your pilgrimage begins as you depart the United States on our international flight.

THURSDAY, MARCH 8 – We will be welcomed by our representative and taken to our hotel in the **Tel Aviv** area. There you will have dinner and overnight.

FRIDAY, MARCH 9 – We'll begin our day with a drive along the coast of the Mediterranean Sea to Caesarea by the Sea. There we'll see the Roman ruins of the great Theater and Aqueduct, as well as the **Crusader city** later built on this site. This is the place where Paul left for his final missionary journey. We'll continue to Mt. Carmel where Elijah confronted the prophets of Baal. Next we'll travel to Megiddo, also known as Armageddon. This is the place where Christians believe the final great battle of the world will be fought. We'll travel to Nazareth where the angel appeared to Mary to announce that she would be the mother of God's Son. This is also the place where Jesus spent his childhood years. From there we'll travel through Cana where Jesus performed his first miracle as we proceed to Tiberias for dinner and overnight.

SATURDAY, MARCH 10 – Today we'll begin with a Boat Ride across the Sea of Galilee where we'll stop for a devotional service. We'll then visit Kibbutz Ginosar where we'll see the ancient boat from the time of Jesus. We'll travel on to Tabgha, the site of the miracle of the multiplication of the loaves and fishes. From there we'll continue our tour with a visit to the hills above the Sea where we find the Mount of Beatitudes. It was here that Jesus gave us the beautiful words from Matthew's gospel. We'll finish our day at Capernaum, the area where Jesus spent most of his ministry and then return to our hotel in Tiberias for dinner and overnight.

SUNDAY, MARCH 11 – Today we'll begin with a drive to see the Roman ruins at **Beit She'an**, which was continuously inhabited for 5000 years. From there we'll continue to visit **Zippori**, not far from Nazareth and a center of learning during the time of Jesus. We'll see the beautiful mosaics and get a feel for the area where Jesus grew up. We'll end our day with a Baptism service at the **Jordan River** before we return to our hotel for dinner and overnight.

MONDAY, MARCH 12 – This morning we will say good-bye to the Galilee and drive through the **Jordan** Valley on our way to Masada, the amazing mountaintop fortress built by Herod, and the site of the final battle in the Jewish Rebellion against the Romans. We'll travel along the **Dead Sea** and pass through the springs of **Ein Gedi** on our way. After our visit there we'll go to the **Allenby Bridge** where we will cross into **Jordan**. We will drive to the Dead Sea for a relaxing evening. Dinner and overnight will be at this beautiful spa hotel.

TUESDAY, MARCH 13 – This morning we will begin with a visit to the Jordan River baptism site near the Dead Sea. We'll see the ruins of several churches built in the Byzantine era to commemorate the baptism of Jesus by John. We'll continue to Mount Nebo from which Moses viewed the Promised Land and then on to the Christian village of Madaba to see the ancient mosaic map of the Holy Land. After our visit there we will continue to Petra for dinner and overnight.

WEDNESDAY, MARCH 14 – Today we'll explore the Red Rose City of Petra. This 2000-year old city was carved by the Nabataens out of the native rock. It has been protected through the centuries by a ring of mountains surrounding the area. Choose between riding a horse or walking to the dramatic canyon where we'll then all walk to the famous Treasury, carved in pink stone. We will continue past the



Roman Theatre, the Corinthian Tomb and the Palace Tomb to the Roman Road. After finishing our visit in Petra, we will drive to Amman for dinner and overnight.

THURSDAY, MARCH 15 — This morning we will return to Allenby Bridge to cross the border back into Israel. We'll visit Qumran where the Dead Sea Scrolls were discovered before going up to Jerusalem where we will visit the Mount of Olives. There we'll see a breathtaking Panoramic View of the Old City of Jerusalem with the Temple Mount and the Dome of the Rock Mosque at the center of the picture. We'll walk a part of the Palm Sunday Road to the Garden of Gethsemane where Jesus went with the disciples on the final night before his crucifixion. There we'll visit the Church of All Nations and the garden with its ancient olive trees. We'll go from there to check in to our hotel in Jerusalem for dinner and overnight.

FRIDAY, MARCH 16 - Our day will begin today with a visit to the Western Wall, the place most precious for Jews around the world. We'll walk through the tunnel that goes under the streets of today with pavement from the time of Jesus. We'll continue from there to the Pool of Bethesda where Jesus healed the crippled man. We'll sing a hymn in the Church of St. Anne before we begin our walk down the Via **Dolorosa**, following the path Jesus took to the cross. We'll visit the Church of the Holy Sepulcher and walk through the fascinating Arab market. We'll tour through the Jewish Quarter where we'll see the Roman Cardo and other sites of interest. Next we'll go to **Mount Zion** where we'll see the **Upper Room**. From there we'll go to the **House of Caiaphas** where Jesus was imprisoned for a night. At the end of our visit there, we'll return to our hotel for dinner and overnight.

SATURDAY, MARCH 17 – We'll begin our day today with a drive to Bethlehem where we'll visit the Nativity Church and see Manger Square. On our way to the church we'll view the Shepherd's Field where the angels appeared to the shepherds to announce the birth of Jesus. From there we'll go to Yad Vashem, the memorial to the Holocaust victims. Nearby, we'll visit the Israel Museum which houses the Dead Sea Scrolls. We'll view the Israeli Knesset, seat of the Israeli Parliament and government offices, and finish the day with a tour of the Model of First Century Jerusalem before returning to our hotel for dinner and overnight.

SUNDAY, MARCH 18 –Today we'll go to the Old City for a culinary and tasting visit with the Chefs for Peace - Christian, Jewish and Moslem chefs who will lead us through the Old City tasting and shopping for ingredients for our lunch. We will have a cooking class and enjoy preparing our lunch with these three chefs! We'll finish our visit in the Holy Land with a very special service of Communion at the Garden Tomb. We'll return to the hotel for our Farewell Dinner in Israel and overnight.

MONDAY, MARCH 19 – This morning we will go to the airport for our flight back to the USA. We'll arrive home with new insights and understandings of the life teachings of Jesus.




